Yellow Stages Strong Comeback In Road Bocce Red Rides Double Wins To Victory

Following 4-Way Volleyball at Winter Camp XL, contested for the first time in camp history at Trout Lake cabin, campers set out for a game of Road Bocce to make their way back to Beaver Creek. Four teams were formed, and the order of the visual spectrum was carefully observed in turn-taking. A spurt of pre-match good sense decreed that the game should not start until Hilltop cabin, otherwise we might still be fighting gravity and ice.

The Red team jumped out to an early lead, aided greatly by two 2-point wins. One was achieved when Dave Oakley of the Gang Green turned the game off of Ranch Road into the site of the former OK Corral, leading to a short round played through deeper snow. Team Yellow trailed badly in the early going, and was listed only as "Also participating" in the scoring record for some time. When the game turned off the road onto the Clearwater Trail, the score was 8-4-4-1 for Red, Blue, Green, and Yellow.

Yellow soon rallied, with four straight wins through the woods to pull into a three-way tie for second place. As the final round crossed the road into Beaver Creek campsite, Yellow's last throw won the round, but Red held on for the win with 8 points, nosing out Green's 7, Yellow's 6, and Blue's 4.

Yesterday's Boodle Fight, likened by some to a Caveman Lunch, kicked off Winter Camp XL with a nod to a Philippine meal tradition discovered and brought to Winter Camp by Jeff Rand. In the Philippines, a Boodle Fight occurs when foodstuffs are laid out on banana leaves and diners are set free to fight their fellows for food. Banana leaves are scarce (at Winter Camp-friendly price points) in North America in December, so we substituted sheets of plastic cut in shapes resembling leaves.

The menu was drawn from the Oakes Lunch, a simple meal of sandwiches and donuts dating back to Winter Camp II and to the Ceremonial Training Seminars (prelude to Winter Camp) which ran from 1976-78, but with "weird noodles" and cheese replacing the traditional chicken noodle soup—which would have been hard to fight for. A number of unusual food combinations emerged from the battle, including donut and salami sandwiches and the creative use of pasta as a donut-hole filler. It was noted by some consumers that the pasta to cheese ratio in the main course was perhaps too high, but many folks agreed that cleanup was very easy.
